## **WINTER DRIVING KIT**

A cell phone is great to have in a car in case you get stuck, but it will not keep you alive in cold weather. Have a back-up plan.

Take the following with you in the passenger compartment of your vehicle because, if you slide into deep snow, you may not be able to get to your trunk:

- \*Bottled water
- \*High calorie snack foods
- \*Nuts, Raisins, and/or Granola Bars
- \*Flashlight and Extra Batteries
- \*Snow Scraper/brush or Broom, and a collapsible shovel.
- \*Blankets or Sleeping Bag or emergency foil blanket or sleeping bag
- \*Extra Warm Clothes, Gloves and Snow Boots
- \*First-aid Kit
- \*Metal Cup (melting snow)
- \*Matches and Candles Housed in a Waterproof Container

But make sure these items are secured to avoid them flying around if your vehicle spins or rolls.

Store the following items in back of your vehicle throughout the winter months:

- \*Tire chains
- \*Bag of Kitty Litter or Sand
- \*Tow Rope Rags or Paper Towels
- \*Jumper Cables
- \*Basic Tool Kit \*Flares
- \*Extra Washer Fluid
