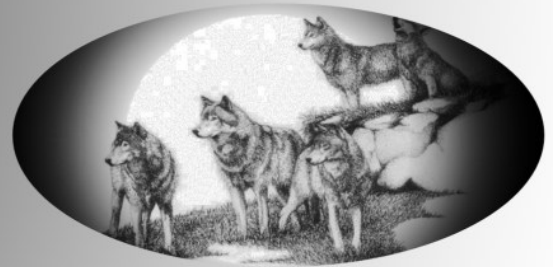

CHAPTER MEETING NEWS

Director (Bart Ziewacz): Bart shared that this year's charity ride will be the Wolf River HOG Chapter Ride for Suicide Awareness. It will be May 10 and benefit the Franki Moscato Foundation. Franki will be in attendance before, during, and after the ride. The ride will cost \$20/rider and depart at Noon. Registration starts at 10am with a Ride Blessing at 11:45am. There is an Officers' Meeting on March 26, 6:30pm in the HOG Barn.

Secretary (Bubb Lidke): There was significant discussion about Jack's Apple Pub being in the Business Tour book. Chapter members shared experiences and reports. The Chapter voted unanimously to not have them in the book and return their application and money.

Membership forms are available at Doc's, the Chapter meeting, or the Chapter website.

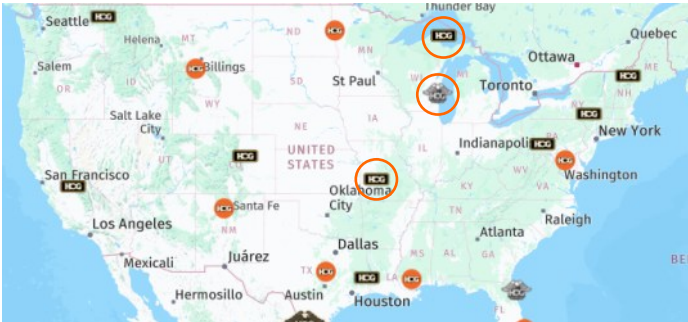
Receive your membership discount card at the Chapter meeting. Get it punched at every meeting or when attending a Chapter event starting at Doc's to get a discount at Doc's.
